### TO THE DIRECTOR

Attention to dynamics is essential to the success of this chart.

Beginning at measure 59, there should be a gradual and steady crescendo that should not depend on merely adding more instruments.

The more dynamic discipline, the more excitement will result.

The piece will also work as a shuffle by substituting the quarter/dotted eighth/sixteenth pattern on the ride cymbal for a repeated dotted eighth/sixteenth pattern.

The brass punches should be tight and crisp. If the instrumentation is complete, the lead trumpet should have the option of resting during the unison passages to stay fresh for the ensemble chorus at the end.

The solo section at measure 29 is open for any soloist, with solo sheets provided in all keys which includes a sample written solo and scales that can be used to encourage young players to create their own solo. Cue backgrounds as desired. Above all, since the essence of jazz is improvisation, encourage your musicians to substitute their ideas for the written solos.
