
## The Elements of Music.

### THE NOTES.

The Musical staff  consists of five parallel lines, and serves to determine the Pitch of the Notes. The Notes are written both on the Lines and between them. Their names are as follows:



To indicate notes of higher or lower pitch than the above, Leger-Lines are used.



The Compass of the Flute comprises the following notes:



The Student should at first learn only the following notes, to which we shall for the present confine ourselves.
