
ARIA AND RONDO

Joseph Hector Fiocco (1703-1741) born in Brussels, Belgium, was of Italian-Belgian heritage. He studied with his father and elder brother and held various church music positions in Antwerp and Brussels. He is known as a composer of keyboard and choral music, a violin maker, and a distinguished harpsichord player of the early eighteenth century.
