For many years he was the music director at a private school and it was here he wrote a large number of concerti for his students. This concerto, originally for strings, is a typical work of Vivaldi's, demonstrating his gift for "tune". It is his melodic material that burns such pieces as the Four Seasons into the memory of musicians and non-musicians alike.
