FOREWORD

The solos in this collection are suitable for contest, recital, class or private study. Each solo is written for two mallets and is playable on either bells, xylophone, vibes or marimba. Mallet suggestions and roll indications (for xylophone and marimba only) are included. Begin practicing the solo with all written dynamics and eventually attaining the indicated metronome tempo. Just a few stickings are included, but as a rule, alternate stickings - RLRL or LRLR. However in some instances it may be necessary to "double-stick" - RR or LL.
