NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The saxophone quartet is one of the most expressive chamber groups for a composer to write for and I hope "Diffusion" exposes the wide and versatile sounds and stylistic range potential of the saxophone quartet. An open mind, good technique in both jazz and classical styles along with a flexible approach is needed to perform all four of the movements.

Movement 1 Allegro

This movement demonstrates the agility and dynamic range of the quartet, as well as the saxophone section's ability to play lush harmonies and light, dancing rhythms with equal aplomb. Tight staccatos (measures 1–4) along with even legato articulations (measures 39–44) are necessary to get the right feel for the piece. This movement should sound "serious" yet "wise guy" at the same time.

Movement 2 Waltz

Blend and balance is the name of the game on this movement. Pay close attention to the balance of the ensemble as the melody is passed between different voices (measures 1–4: the soprano passes the melodic line to the alto in measures 5–8). Listen to each other and blend to nail the fast triplet lines in measures 29, 30, 65, and 66.

Movement 3 Swing

Here's where the quartet must showcase its' jazz chops with a great sense of time to execute the swing feel. This is not an easy task at the slow tempo, especially with all the rests between the figures and no rhythm section to fill in the

breaks. Each member of the quartet must have a good inner sense of time and then come to a consensus of a collaborative group time. This is accomplished by practicing/rehearsing this movement with a metronome, both individually and as an ensemble.

Movement 4 Hip Hop

This movement is quite difficult, for a variety of reasons. First off, the modern up-tempo Hip Hop feel requires extreme rhythmic accuracy, and the time needs to be locked-in, right from the start; again with no drummer to propel things along. Next, there are some real finger-busters in this movement. Lots of slow practice is required, especially on the complex fugue that occurs after the solo section. And speaking of the solo section, here's where "Diffusion" sets itself apart from more traditional quartet literature. Members of the quartet are called upon to display their improvisation skills. Chord changes are provided in the soprano, alto and tenor parts. Improvising is a separate discipline unto itself, and requires years of study to master, but dive right in and have fun!

IV. Hip Hop
