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### MICKEY NICOLAS

René Nicolas, beter bekend als Mickey NICOLAS werd op 18 januari 1926 in Laon in het Noorden van Frankrijk geboren. Deze saxofonist, componist en dirigent, studeerde saxofoon aan het Conservatorium van Parijs bij de bekende virtuoos Marcel Mule. Als componist is hij volledig autodidact en sinds 1944 lid van de SACEM (de Franse componisten-vereniging). Van 1977 tot 1990 was hij tweede dirigent aan het beroemde Parijse cabaret "Le Lido". Hij componeerde een tiental filmpartituren, diverse werken voor cabaret- en variététheaters en voor televisie-uitzendingen, balletmuziek en liedjes.

### MICKEY NICOLAS

René Nicolas, mieux connu sous le pseudonyme Mickey NICOLAS est né le 18 janvier 1926 à Laon dans le Nord de la France. Ce saxophoniste, compositeur et chef d'orchestre a étudié le saxophone au Conservatoire National Supérieur de Paris dans la classe de Marcel Mule. Ce compositeur autodidacte est membre de la SACEM depuis 1944. De 1977 à 1990 il est chef d'orchestre adjoint au LIDO, le célèbre cabaret parisien. Il a composé une dizaine de musiques de film, des musiques de Variétés pour divers spectacles et ballets, plusieurs chansons et de nombreuses sonorisations.

### MICKEY NICOLAS

René Nicolas, alias Mickey NICOLAS wurde am 18. Januar 1926 in Laon im Norden Frankreichs geboren. Dieser Komponist und Dirigent studierte das Saxophon bei dem berühmten Professor Marcel Mule am Pariser Konservatorium. Als Komponist ist er Autodidakt und ist er seit 1944 Mitglied der S.A.C.E.M. (des französischen Komponistenvereins). Von 1977 bis 1990 war er zweiter Dirigent am bekannten Pariser Kabarett "Le Lido". Er hat Musik für zehn Filme und verschiedene Spektakel und Ballette und manche Lieder komponiert.

### MICKEY NICOLAS

René Nicolas, better known as Mickey NICOLAS was born on 18 January 1926 in Laon in the North of France. This composer and conductor studied the saxophone with Marcel Mule at the Paris Conservatory. As a composer he is completely self-taught and since 1944 he is a member of the SACEM (French Composers Association). He is an assistant-conductor at the famous Parisian cabaret "Le Lido". He composed some ten film scores, music for ten films and various spectacles and ballets and many songs.



### PARIS CHANSONS - arr. Mickey Nicolas

De Franse componist Mickey Nicolas (Laon, 1926) was jarenlang als dirigent aan het beroemde Parijse cabaret "Le Lido" verbonden. Met "Listening to Paris" bewees hij reeds hoeveel hij van de Lichtstad hield. Met "Paris Chansons" brengt hij een leuke medley met knappe arrangementen van liedjes die de Franse hoofdstad roemen en ook bekend gemaakt hebben. U hoort "Sous les Ponts de Paris", "Sous les Toits de Paris", "La Seine", "Sur les Quais du Vieux Paris", "Mademoiselle de Paris", "Pigalle", "Moulin Rouge", "Paris", "La Romance de Paris", "Paris je t'aime d'Amour" en "Paris Reine du Monde". Met dit werk breng je ongetwijfeld de Parijse sfeer in de concertzaal.

### PARIS CHANSONS - arr. Mickey Nicolas

Le compositeur français Mickey Nicolas (Laon, 1926) a été de nombreuses années chef d'orchestre au célèbre cabaret Parisien "Le Lido". Il avait déjà illustré son grand amour pour la Ville Lumière avec son oeuvre "En écoutant Paris" (Listening to Paris). Avec "Paris Chansons" il a écrit un merveilleux pot-pourri avec de très bons arrangements de chansons connues qui font l'éloge de la capitale française et qui ont aidé à la rendre célèbre dans le monde entier. Ce bouquet de chansons est composé des airs immortels suivants: "Sous les Ponts de Paris", "Sous les Toits de Paris", "La Seine", "Sur les Quais du Vieux Paris", "Mademoiselle de Paris", "Pigalle", "Moulin Rouge", "Paris", "La Romance de Paris", "Paris je t'aime d'Amour" et "Paris Reine du Monde". Cette composition créera certainement une ambiance parisienne dans votre salle de concert.

### PARIS CHANSONS - arr. Mickey Nicolas

Der französische Komponist Mickey Nicolas (Laon, 1926) war jahrelang zweiter Dirigent am berühmten Pariser Cabaret "Le Lido". Er hatte schon seine große Liebe für die Lichtstadt Paris in seiner Komposition "Listening to Paris" ausgedrückt. Mit "Paris Chansons" hat er ein wunderschönes Medley geschrieben mit ausgezeichneten Arrangements von bekannten Liedern die die französische Hauptstadt weltüber bekannt und beliebt gemacht haben. Dieser Liederstrauch enthält die folgenden unsterblichen Lieder: "Sous les Ponts de Paris", "Sous les Toits de Paris", "La Seine", "Sur les Quais du Vieux Paris", "Mademoiselle de Paris", "Pigalle", "Moulin Rouge", "Paris", "La Romance de Paris", "Paris je t'aime d'Amour" und "Paris Reine du Monde".

### PARIS CHANSONS - arr. Mickey Nicolas

The French composer Mickey Nicolas (Laon, 1926) was conductor at the famous Paris cabaret "Le Lido" for many years. He already expressed his great love for the Eiffel Tower City by composing "Listening to Paris". With "Paris Chansons" (Paris Songs) he wrote a splendid medley with fine arrangements of famous French songs that glorified the French capital and spread its reputation all over the world. This nice anthology of immortal French songs contains the following songs: "Sous les Ponts de Paris", "Sous les Toits de Paris", "La Seine", "Sur les Quais du Vieux Paris", "Mademoiselle de Paris", "Pigalle", "Moulin Rouge", "Paris", "La Romance de Paris", "Paris je t'aime d'Amour" and "Paris Reine du Monde". This composition will bring some Parisian atmosphere in the concert hall.
