## About This Composition

This is the story of John Philip Sousa, presented with some of the music from his most famous marches. Sousa was a colossal star, and his professional band was recognized as the greatest in the world. He became an American icon.

The year 2004 marked the 150th anniversary of the birth of this great American, and this new presentation of his music and his story makes it possible for bands and audiences to celebrate the musical legacy and heritage which he left for us all.

The marches you will hear include: Washington Post, El Capitan, Semper Fidelis, and The Stars and Stripes Forever.

## About the Composer

**Robert E. Foster** has been on the music faculty at the University of Kansas since 1971 when he became the University's Director of Bands, a position he held for 31 years. As Director of Bands, his bands performed at national conventions for the American Bandmasters Association, Music Educators National Conference, College Band Directors National Association, the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors, and at numerous state and regional conferences. He is presently Professor of Music, and Assistant Chairman of the Department of Music and Dance, and he is also the Educational Consultant for Wingert-Jones Publications.

Born and raised in Texas where his father was a school band director, his degrees are from the University of Texas and the University of Houston. His teaching career began in the public schools in Texas, including teaching at the junior high school and the senior high school levels before going to the University of Florida where he became Associate Director of Bands and Professor of Trumpet.

With well over 100 publications for band, he has published arrangements and compositions for bands of all kinds and at all levels, and he is constantly in demand as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator.

He is past-president and chairman of the board of directors of the American Bandmasters Association, the National Band Association, and the Southwest Division of the College Band Directors National Association, and he is presently on the Executive Board of the John Philip Sousa Foundation.
