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About the Composer

Robert E. Foster, Jr. is the Associate Director of Bands and Coordinator of Instrumental Music Education at Tennessee Tech University in Cookeville, Tennessee. His responsibilities include directing the Golden Eagle marching Band, Concert Band, Basketball bands, teaching music education courses and supervising student teachers. Mr. Foster has held similar positions at the University of Maryland, Texas Christian University and Haskell Indian Nations University. In addition to his twelve years experience at the college level, he also taught in the Kansas public schools and USD #491 where he directed the Eudora High School Band, Middle School Band, Beginning Band and taught elementary music classes.

Mr. Foster has written original music compositions for a wide range of musical levels including works for young bands to works written specifically for several of the leading military bands. Several of these original compositions are published by Wingert-Jones Publications and Curnow Music Press. He has also written over 75 marching band arrangements.

Program Notes

Emblem of Freedom was written specifically for the 1st Kansas Sousa Junior Honor Band and was premiered at the Inaugural Concert in Lawrence, Kansas on January 21, 2003. This composition was written with the intention that it would become a tradition and a staple piece for this honor band and would serve as the opener for each Kansas Sousa Junior Honor Band concert, year after year.

The composer writes: “My goal was to create an exciting piece for young bands which sounds difficult, but in actuality is very playable by most middle school bands. There are plenty of percussion parts to keep your students involved! The brassy fanfares, woodwind flourishes, and percussion interlude create a powerful and majestic opener which will set the confidence level of your young band and will excite your audience.”
