

Note 2 In the absence of Bell Tree, use either of the following three substitutes 1. Remove all the bars from an extra Glockenspiel and string them together chromatically. Play a slow glissando, pianissimo, using a medium rubber mallet. 2 Play a two-octave G to G white-note glissando on a Vibraphone (motor off) with wire brushes, piano. 3. Strike the edge of a large and heavy suspended cymbal once, piano, with a medium yarn mallet and let vibrate. (If possible, use a Chinese cymbal.)

Note 3. In the absence of Tam-tam, substitute a metallic swish sound using either of the following methods 1 Use a pair of cymbals, holding one cymbal in a horizontal or vertical position Push the edge of the other cymbal from the bell outwards – inside the plate of the stationery cymbal – and let vibrate, plano. 2. Use a suspended cymbal Scrape a com from the bell outwards and let vibrate, plano.

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
