

# James M. Stephenson YEHTUDES – the story:

In the summer of 2018, I approached John Yeh, the assistant principal and solo E-flat clarinetist of the Chicago Symphony, about collaborating on a clarinet etude book. John and I had just finished a CD project with Cedille Records ("Liquid Melancholy"), which contained a lot of my solo and chamber clarinet music, yet I still felt inspired to create more music for clarinet. Furthermore, John's daughter, Molly, had recently been making big headlines as a food-blogger (resulting in a subsequent TV show), and upon a visit to her blog ("My Name is Yeh"), I discovered a list of cake recipes that I found to be musically inspiring. And with that, the idea for "Yehtudes" was born.

Following the example of a previous project I had done with trumpet players, John and I together sent out a notice to any interested clarinetists to see if they might like to "subscribe" to the project.

To the right is a list of all of the brave clarinetists who signed on, and who agree to receive "world premiere Yehtude" in the email inboxes, for their own firsthend less to each one, just created that day.

I attempted to address (with John shelp) 12 different points of study for the clarifier, but to do so in a way that would simult neously be musically rewarding.

I also cycled through all of the keys, alternating between notion and minor, to try to capture as many musical possibilities as I could, when the orien 12-etude process.

Al' of this pok, lace during the month of July, 2018, and the result is the set of etudes contained in the subsequent pages.

Of ote – as of this date – Yehtudes #5 ("c rawberry Hi-Hat Cupcakes") and #8 ("Italian Rainbow Cookie Cake") come with accompaniment. The former uses hi-hat (due to the title), while the latter uses piano. The hi-hat is included herein, while the piano accompaniment for #8 is sold separately at ComposerJim.com.

#### from composer in stephenson:

This "Yehtude" is created as an effort to focus on the commonly known breaks that exist for the clarinet player. Rather than to continually compose notes the dear with these well-known notes/intervals, I decided instead to try to create something that is (hopefully) musually rewarding, where the player's primary goal is to focus on music, and to over me technical issues in order to achieve their artistic vision.

This is what would most account in the repertoire, and it was my goal to emulate that idea.

Tempos should be used only an a guideline. Each player may choose to go slower or faster, per their particular needs.

I thought Maly's " agboy attle would coordinate best with an etude dealing with "breaks".

I hope you enjoy a sens of humor with all of that, and that it makes you feel "sunny side up", as John put it.
