To The Director

Ave Verum Corpus is among Mozart's best known works. This setting for string orchestra should focus the student's attention on linear cantabile playing with smooth, flexible bow changes. Warmth and depth of sound - even at the softer dynamic levels - must be of prime concern.

Pay very close attention to the raised position of many C#'s as they provide the color tone of the dominant 7th chord. The tonality shift at measure 22 should be clearly understood by the performers.

This is both an excellent teaching piece and a strong addition to a program that requires contrast in mood and style.
