Combined with an introductory theme from the suite, this overture is among the most majestic pieces of Baroque music ever written. Perfectly set as a first full orchestra experience, the contrasting statements of the themes are regal and fun to play.

PROGRAM NOTES

Handel's *Royal Fireworks Music* was commissioned by the English government to celebrate the peace that ended the War of Austrian Succession in 1748. This famous overture is among the most majestic Baroque music ever written and the composer's colorful orchestration is highlighted by his use of string and wind choirs in contrasting statements of the themes. In this arrangement, Handel's original overture (m. 9) is preceded by a Minuet theme (found elsewhere in the original suite), which serves as an attention-getting fanfare for the regal music that follows.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The dynamics found in this arrangement are the arranger's. Since performance practices in Handel's time were much less standardized than they are today, teachers may wish to alter the dynamics or even have students suggest their own dynamic schemes. Teachers may also wish to consider combining this Overture with the *First Philharmonic* arrangement of Handel's "La Rejouissance" (00-29746) for a more complete *Royal Fireworks Music* experience.
