eightth rest = $\frac{1}{2}$ count of silence in $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{4}{4}$, or C ; an eighth rest is as long as an eighth note

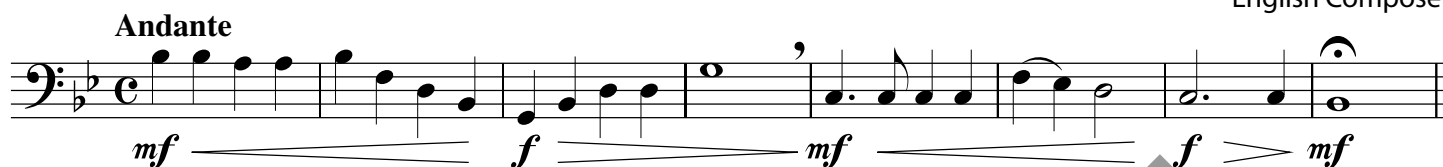

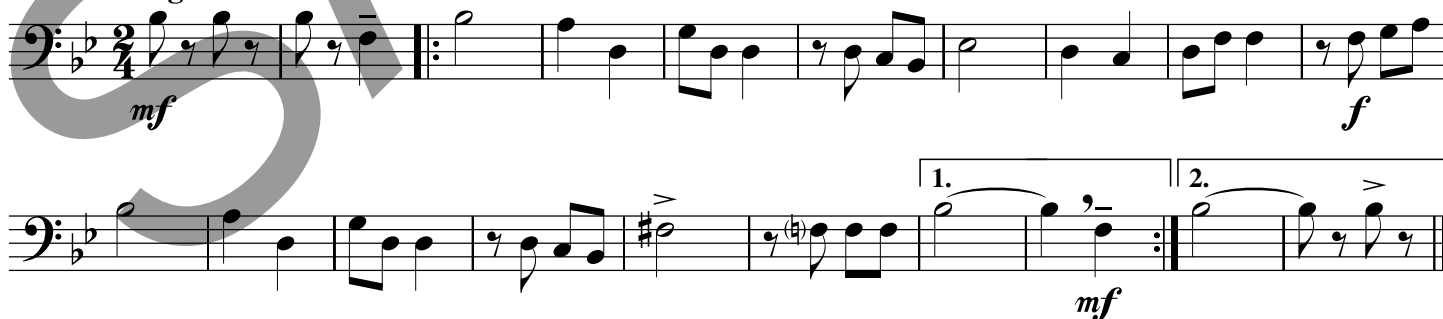
