NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Cheep Tricks is my newest attempt to “funk-i-fy” the common chicken. It also references a band that is surely a blast from the past (Tower of Power). I highly recommend having your students listen to the Alfred Music/Belwin Jazz demo of this tune (available at alfred.com/downloads) to get a great idea of what it can sound like.

This tune leans on the rock side, with funky overtones. Be sure to exaggerate dynamics when needed. For example, pay attention to the *mp* *crescendo* in m. 4. The groove of the tune starts at m. 6 and adds more instruments as the section is repeated. The music should be played crisp and clean. It will sound a little fractured, but that’s correct. Don’t over play, save it for later.

And then, m. 42 is later. Here the brass should be big and full. Create dynamic movement that follows the shape of the lead trumpet melody line. Start dynamically strong, and then drop down a touch to *crescendo* back up. This should repeat every two measures. The band is mostly *tutti*, with some saxophone lines in between brass figures. Make sure the saxes really bring these lines out.

The solo section has space for tenor sax and guitar solos, with written solos provided. I strongly encourage the soloists to create their own improvisation. Don’t let the rhythm section bring this section too far down dynamically—we are rockin’ out! Be sure to exaggerate dynamics in the sax lines every four measures. Consider having each soloist play the section twice, with backgrounds on the second and fourth time. My favorite way to do this: have each soloist take the first and second endings. Then play the section between solos at m. 68, repeating back to m. 50 after m. 75. But you should decide what is best for your players.

At m. 76, most of the rhythm section is *tacet*. Therefore, the horns should not be too loud here, for contrast. Be sure winds play crisply and that the baritone saxophone shines. Bring it all home from m. 86 to the end. I hope you have fun with this one—get funky!
