NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Jive Samba is one of my favorite “groove tunes” of all time and I was thrilled when I was asked to write a new arrangement of this classic! It would be extremely helpful for your rhythm section and the entire band to listen to the demo recording of this chart available at alfred.com. Also, check out Cannonball Adderley’s original recording if you can.

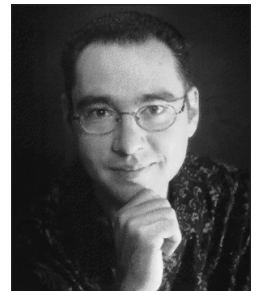
Please ensure that the articulations are exaggerated. The arrangement will groove much harder if the staccatos are short and in contrast to the other articulations. Quarter notes on downbeats that have the rooftop accent should be fat, but not long or short—think “daht.” Make the most out of the f dynamics throughout the arrangement.

Make sure the soloists do not get too hung up on the chord changes. Until the (concert) $\text{B}\flat 13$ chord, an F blues scales would sound great over these changes. Please have a saxophonist take the last solo. This will allow all the brass players to be available to play at the beginning of the shout chorus at measure 72.

The last note should stand apart from the other quarter notes in that it should be played at least full length, which will give the chart a great sense of closure.

Thanks for your interest in this chart! I sincerely hope you, the band, and the audience enjoy it!
