NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This is a pretty wacky chart. The basic feel is a quasi-New Orleans groove, which is essentially defined by the snare drum pattern and a strong sense of swing, which is why I chose to notate some of the figures with an eighth notes triplet notation, just to remind the band to swing the eighth notes *hard*.

The piano opens the chart with an ostinato figure, soon to be joined by the guitar player. Both players should play with a solid time feel because they are setting the table for the whole rhythmic feel of this chart. The trumpets and alto saxes state the melody at measure 17 and things groove along, kinda sassy until 49, where the chart takes a bit of a left turn...but I'm not sure why. At this point, begin to build with various instruments layering on a series of individual lines. This segues back into the original feel and melody at measure 65, and before you know it the band is at the solo section. The groove in this section is slightly altered by adding a "Bo Diddly" pattern in the bass and kick drum. It would be ideal if the soloist(s) on this chart would play with the spirit and emotion of the great New Orleans musicians. Brass players could use plunger mutes, or sax players could employ scoops and vibrato of that style. But whatever you do, do it with attitude and emotion!

After the solos, the chart goes into a development section (measure 131) where each section plays around with different fragments of the melody until 147, where the rhythm section (except for the bongos) drops out. Here, the saxes must keep the time moving forward—don't drag! This part should not be very loud because you want the chord at measure 154 to plaster the listener to the wall. Keep in mind it will sound all the more powerful if the band is more restrained leading up to it. Get the band into a quasi 2-beat feel at measure 156 (it should still swing, though), and then reprise the build-up section at 164, but this time one of your soloists should blow over the top. Don't forget measures 178–179, which have the soloist and drums and percussion going nuts, leading to the final chorus. If the band gets to measures 208 and 210 and doesn't have enough gas to do those lip trills, no sweat. Just put a nice *slz* crescendo on the "and of 4" of measures 207 and 209. Above all, these measures need to really scream.

Thanks for picking up this chart. I had fun writing it. I hope you have fun playing it!
