NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Chameleon is considered a jazz standard and is composed by world-renowned jazz pianist and composer, Herbie Hancock, along with Paul Jackson, Harvey Mason, Jr. and Bennie Maupin. This funk tune embraces elements of rock and soul while adopting freer stylistic elements from jazz.

This entire arrangement is to be played with a moderate laid back “funk feel.” It is suggested that students listen to the classic Herbie Hancock recording, *Head Hunters*, and the Maynard Ferguson recording, *Chameleon*, not only to compare and contrast, but to get a feel for the intended groove. Remember that jazz is still basically an aural art form. Additionally, a recording of this arrangement may be found at www.alfred.com/downloads.

Accurate and consistent articulation is critical throughout this chart. In measure 1, the sixteenth-note figure is articulated like “doo-dit.” Note that the *sfz* on the fourth beat of measure 1 is different than a traditional *sforzando* marking. Release the whole note in measure 2 on beat 4. Starting with the pickups, the bass line, which also appears 4th trombone and bari sax, should not be rushed—play it even and accurately. The repetitive element of this composition builds the intensity and focuses on the groove. At measure 11, the melody is introduced by the alto, tenor, trumpet and trombone. Direct those players to listen carefully to each other to match articulation and phrasing. The contrasting trombone figures behind the melody at measure 34 should be consistent and tight to match the bass, bass trombone and bari sax.

The solo section in measures 53–68 provides opportunity for individual solos, section soli, and other possible combinations. A suggested written solo is provided for all of the wind instruments, but encourage students to improvise. There are only two chords in the solo section chord progression (concert Gm^7 and C^7) and they both use the (concert) F major scale. The written solo can be effective as it will encourage young players to solo and develop self-confidence.

Notice that the keyboard and guitar parts have a slight variation of the previous accompaniment and that the drum hi-hat becomes more active. For the solo section only, if there are additional rhythm players, one can play the shaker to double the hi-hat and another play the large cowbell in a quarter-note pattern.
