NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

On a Misty Night was composed by Tadd Dameron, an American jazz composer, arranger, and pianist in the “bop” era. It was originally recorded on the album *Mating Call* featuring John Coltrane. This arrangement is an accessible vehicle for young performers and a great way to introduce the music of Tadd Dameron.

This arrangement of *On a Misty Night* is written to be played as a slow swing or a “walking ballad” tempo. Although it can work at a slightly quicker tempo, it offers performers the opportunity to learn the discipline of achieving a laid-back swing feel.

The form of the tune is AABA. At m. 37, the sax section has a brief four-measure soli followed by a full ensemble to finish the A section. That is followed at m. 47 with a tenor sax solo with the second A section. The saxes play the bridge (B) melody at m. 53, and then the final A section has a trumpet solo.

Regarding articulation, the staccatos are short but not clipped or too short. The *marcato*, or rooftop, accents are detached and accented—think “daht.”

Stylistically, the sax soli at m. 37 is played  and relaxed, not too intense. Please direct the players to observe the dynamics and always listen to their section and the entire ensemble for blend and balance. The ensemble should always hold notes their full value for a clean release. Clean releases make every band sound polished and more mature. The tenor and trumpet soloists can play the suggested solo, an embellished version, or improvise.

An interesting aspect of this tune is that over time, a second bridge melody seems to have evolved. The bridge melody at m. 53 is the melody recorded by Coltrane. An alternate bridge melody has appeared in lead sheets and recordings over time; this is the initial bridge melody used in the arrangement at m. 21. The introduction and the ending have the harmonic structure used in the original Coltrane recording as well as other recordings.

This is a classic example of Dameron’s ability to take a simple idea and turn it into a musical gem. I hope you enjoy Tadd Dameron’s *On a Misty Night*.
