Vince Gassi

Vince Gassi is a much sought-after composer, conductor, and clinician. With over 100 published titles to his credit, Vince's creative and energetic style has made him a favourite with young musicians. His works, both challenging and musically rewarding, appear on many international concert and contest lists.

Vince received his Bachelor of Music from the University of Western Ontario in London, Canada and later studied composing and arranging at the renowned Dick Grove School of Music in Los Angeles, California. He recently completed his Ph.D. at York University in Toronto, Canada.

For twenty-five years Vince has taught Instrumental Music at the elementary and secondary school levels. He is in frequent demand as a guest conductor, adjudicator, and clinician throughout the United States and Canada. His *Cool Ideas*, *Arranging Concepts*, *Digital Workflows*, and *Creativity Workouts* seminars focus on ways to engage students and teachers in the creative process.

Vince continues to receive many commissions and his works have been recorded and performed throughout North America, Europe, and Japan. Vince currently lives Toronto.

October Rain

Everyone needs a warm fuzzy when the leaves turn color, and the crisp autumn air comes our way. Just imagine curling up by the fireplace with a cup of hot cocoa and a warm blanket and you're in the perfect mood for the soft edges of *October Rain*. The rich harmonies and poignant melody of this easy ballad will chase all your troubles away.

Conductor Notes

Part of what makes this chart expressive are the subtleties found throughout. Some examples: brushes swirling on the Snare Drum throughout, arpeggiated figures in Guitar and/or Piano matched in the Brass with staggered entries (measure 24-25 for example), the Trombone short glissando or bend into the note (M27-41), the Bass playing off the beat (M18) and the slide at M19. Also note that there are many places throughout that are marked with *crescendi*, *decrescendi* or both (M39-40).

The harmonies are lush and the Piano solo should be played tenderly followed by a build up into the Sax soli (M33). Harmon mutes (no stem) in the Trumpets and cup mutes in the Trombones are a must at M37. Finally, the last chord (M46) which is an Fmaj13 (#11) is so much better when the Bass can be heard entering subtly in the final measure. Of course, working to achieve balance and blend is critical to achieving the warmth this piece was meant to express.
