**Introduction and Allegro** was composed for the Claughton Middle School Symphonic Band, Houston (Spring), Texas, under the direction of Ogechi Ukazu for performance at the 2011 Midwest International Band and Orchestra Conference.

The **Introduction and Allegro** is scored for young band and would be playable by both middle schools and high schools. The composition is a grade 2.5 with an extended percussion section (Timpani and 5 percussionists) that is a grade. The request from conductor Ukazu was a composition that was contemporary and that featured mallet percussion. The most challenging aspects of this work will be the harmonic language and driving syncopation.

This work marks 19 consecutive years for composer Leroy Osmon to have works premiered at the Midwest Clinic. All previous Midwest performances of compositions are recorded by Mark Custom Recording and are published by RBC Music, San Antonio, Texas.
