JAMES SUDDUTH

James Sudduth has served as Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas since 1981. Previous to this appointment, he was Director of Bands at Southwest Texas State University in San Marcos, Texas since 1974. Prior teaching experience in public schools includes seven years in the Lubbock Public Schools. He received both Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Music Education from Texas Tech University. In the fall of 1970 he was appointed Assistant Professor of Music and Director of the Marching Band at Northwestern University, Evanston, Illinois. While at Northwestern he served on the staff of New Music Reviews for THE INSTRUMENTALIST magazine. Mr. Sudduth has written and arranged more than 300 compositions for both marching and concert bands. He is very active as a clinician, conductor and adjudicator. Mr. Sudduth is a member of the Texas Music Educator Association, Texas Bandmasters Association, College Band Directors National Association, Phi Mu Alpha, Pi Kappa Lambda, and holds an honorary membership in Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma. He was honored by Omicron Delta Kappa and Morter Board for outstanding service to Texas Tech University in 1982. In the fall of 1985, he and W. Francis McBeth were honored with the National Citation of Excellence Award by Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Fraternity of America for outstanding contributions in music. He served as conductor of the University Symphony Orchestra in 1987-88 and guest conducts the Lubbock Symphony each year for "The Nutcracker" Ballet. Most recently, he was the first American Conductor invited to guest-conduct the Seoul Wind Ensemble, Seoul, Korea, in October of 1988.

VARIATIONS ON A DANISH FOLK SONG

The folk song on which this composition is based is translated: "Out of the Deep, Dark, Quiet of the Forest." It begins with a brief fanfare, based on the first three notes of the folk song. Then enters the first thematic statement, reflecting the translation with smooth, rich orchestration, with clarinet melody in the lowest octave. Then comes a full band orchestration, again with rich full colors.

Three cadenzas follow, again based on the first three notes of the folk song, by bassoon, alto saxophone and flute. Technical demands are limited and there are plenty of cross-cueings in insure the playability of the cadenzas. The percussion introduces the next variation which is repeated twice. Contrapuntal lines are added with each repeat in march-like fashion. Another brief flute cadenza interlude precedes the final allegro variation which features the tune in an augmented manner.

Variations on a Danish Folk Song was commissioned in honor of the Hildebrandt Intermediate School Band and was performed at their 1989 Texas Music Educators Honor Band Concert, Scott McAdow, Director.
