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Doug Beach

Doug Beach is a performer, composer, publisher, educator, arranger, and Grammy Award winner.

At Elmhurst College (IL), where he has taught since 1978, he serves as director of the acclaimed Elmhurst College Jazz Band and as director of jazz studies. Under his direction, the Jazz Band has made over 20 European tours (twice at the invitation of the U.S. State Department) and has performed in jazz festivals across the world.

Beach is equally well known for his work as a publisher and composer. His company, Doug Beach Music, is one of the world's leading publishers of educational jazz music, and each year since 1995 he has been the recipient of a Plus Award from the American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP). In 1996, the Count Basie Orchestra and New York Voices recorded his arrangement of *Cottontail* on a CD that went on to win the Grammy Award for best large jazz ensemble.

Grandview Groove

The foundation to a successful performance of *Grandview Groove* lies in the Shuffle-funk groove created by the rhythm section. The eighth notes that the horns play should swing throughout.

All players should closely observe all articulation markings. Singing the melody is a great way to help students gain a grasp of the articulations. With the rhythm section laying down the groove, and the horn players should all pay close attention to the groove lock in with it.

The solo section at bar 52 may be opened up. Improvisation should be encouraged, but written solos are provided. Backgrounds may be cued as desired.

The Drums trade two bar figures with the ensemble beginning at bar 65. The Drummer should be sure to stay true to the groove in those two bar solos.

The full ensemble takes over following the solo section. Again, articulations are a key element to a successful performance. The chart should go out strong.
