In addition, she is lead teacher and coordinator of the ASTA with NSOA String Project, a teacher-training program at Lawrence University in Appleton.

A member of the Wisconsin School Music Association/Wisconsin Music Educators Association, Ms. Gruselle is past orchestra coordinator for the WSMA Middle Level Honors Project, and is currently a member of the WMEA Comprehensive Musicianship Through Performance Committee. Her arrangements and compositions for beginning and developing string players are performed across the nation and abroad.

About the Music

Although he was born in Germany, George Frideric Handel spent much of his life in England. *Music for the Royal Fireworks* was written in 1749 for King George II to accompany a fireworks celebration in London.

La Réjouissance, or the Rejoicing, should be played joyfully. Bow strokes include marcato or martelé for the quarter notes, and legato or détaché for the eighth notes, to emulate the enthusiastic Baroque style. *Minuet and Trio* should sound grand and stately, as the fireworks celebration would have required.

Set comfortably in two sharps with the only low second finger patterns in violin 1, students can focus on tone, intonation, and style.
