About the Composer

Clarence Barber taught public school in Ohio for 31 years, including 21 years with the Midview Local Schools. A graduate of Kent State University, he has also done post-graduate work at Kent State and the University of Akron. Mr. Barber studied composition with Walter Watson and Ralph Turek and percussion with Larry Snider, Michael Rosen, and James Adkins. Currently the band editor for LudwigMasters Publications and Southern Music Company, he has served on the adjunct faculty at the Baldwin-Wallace University Conservatory of Music and Lorain County Community College. His compositions have been played around the world, including many written for his students at Midview and for members of the United States Air Force and Army Bands, and members of the Cleveland Orchestra. As a percussionist, he has been a member of the Akron and Canton (OH) Symphony Orchestras, the Blossom Festival Band, Blossom Festival Orchestra, Virginia Grand Military Band, Strongsville Community Band, and the Patriot Symphonic Band.

Program Notes

Alien Autopsy was composed for the composer's granddaughter and her high school band. Loras John Schissel was kind enough to donate his title idea. Odd percussion sounds and unusual scoring give the "alien" touch to the work. Let's not forget that making music, especially for students, is supposed to be FUN!

Performance Notes

All solo passages are cross-cued to give flexibility to the conductor. Percussion instruments and trombone *glissandi* should be brought to the fore for best effect. The soda straw effect in the flute will be LOUD... but that's OK, let it soar! An acceptable substitute is to play on a piccolo head joint. Start with a pencil inserted in the open end and gradually withdraw the pencil for the downward *glissando*. Remember always that melody comes first when balancing parts. Solo players should make their piano dynamic as the softest at which they can play with a good tone. If it is a little louder than a section's piano, so be it. Good tone is always our first concern.
