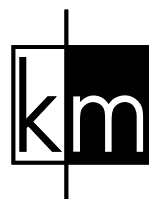

Gregory Yasinitsky, Regents Professor of Music and Coordinator of Jazz Studies at Washington State University, is conductor of the Jazz Education Network All Stars Big Band, which includes some of the most acclaimed musicians in the world, and has written music especially for David Sanborn, Sean Jones, Clark Terry, Jeff Coffin, Dave Liebman and the USAF "Airmen of Note" big band. Yasinitsky's music is performed in forty countries world-wide and he has performed with Randy Brecker, Marcus Printup, Tom Harrell, Ed Calle, Alex Acuna, Kirk Whalum, Claudio Roditi, Conrad Herwig, Sarah Vaughan, Ella Fitzgerald, Ray Charles, Louis Bellson, Stan Getz, Lionel Hampton, Lou Rawls, Manhattan Transfer, and many others.

Acapulco Nights

Acapulco Nights is fun Latin tune with an infectious groove scored for developing bands. The chart features a catchy melody, fun rhythms, rich harmonies and solidly scored ensemble passages. There are approachable solos for Trombone 1 and Trumpet 2. Suggested written solos are provided, but your soloists are encouraged to improvise. For the solo section, measures 65-80, one scale will work throughout, for the Trombone, G Dorian (G, A, B $\flat$, C, D, E, F) and for the Trumpet, A Dorian (A, B, C, D, E, F $\sharp$, G). *Acapulco Nights* is scored with flexible instrumentation, playable by as few as 3 Saxophones (AAT), 2 Trumpets, 1 Trombone and 3 rhythm (PBD) or any combination up to a 17 piece big band. There are also optional parts included for Flute, Clarinet, Horn in F and Tuba.
