TO THE DIRECTOR

This is an uptempo flagwaver, which features solos for 1st Alto Saxophone, 2nd Trumpet and piano, as well as a saxophone soli and an ensemble chorus which moves from a whisper to a roar.

Work to have your ensemble achieve a relaxed, swinging, up tempo groove. It is suggested that the rhythm section spends some time rehearsing without the horns. The drummer should play the high hat with conviction for a loud "chick" sound on beats 2 and 4. The bassist should lock in with the drummer's ride cymbal. It is not necessary to have the drummer play the bass drum on every beat, and discourage your drummer from playing the bass drum only on beats 1 and 3 as this will make it sound as if the groove is in two rather than a fast four.

With the horn players, work for ensemble precision. Agreement on note lengths and releases will enhance your performance. Also, emphasize dynamic contrasts. This piece includes passages at all dynamic levels, from as soft to as loud as the band can play. Emphasizing dynamics will showcase the musicality of your group.
