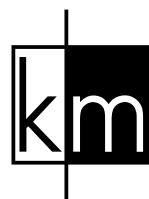

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Kris Berg

Kris Berg is an international best-selling composer and arranger. He has written charts for Kurt Elling, Sean Jones, Veronica Swift, Delfeayo Marsalis, Wayne Bergeron and Chris Vadala, for honors bands in Texas, Oklahoma, Arizona, South Carolina, Maine, Maryland and Missouri, and for professional, college and public school bands around the globe.

A recipient of 8 Global Music Awards, Mr. Berg has released two highly acclaimed CD's (MAMA Records) as leader of the Metroplexity Big Band. "Time Management" and "This Time/Last Year" feature his unique writing and arranging. "Perspectives", his new CD, was released in 2021. He has appeared or recorded with the likes of Wayne Bergeron, Phil Woods, Kurt Elling, Randy Brecker, Peter Erskine, Delfeayo Marsalis, and Bob Mintzer and has directed All-State Jazz Bands in Nebraska, Montana, Oklahoma, Maine, South Carolina, Arkansas, South Dakota, Nevada, Kentucky, Ohio, Arizona, Texas and Wyoming.

Kris is currently the Jazz Program Director for the Greater Dallas Youth Orchestra program and Music Director at Willow Bend Church in Plano, Texas. He taught college for almost 30 years and is the founder of the award-winning Jazz Program at Collin College including the Collin Jazz Fest and the Texas All-Star Jazz Camp.

Mind Over Matters

Mind Over Matters is a moderately up-tempo cool swing chart based on C minor blues. Scoring that features support as well as independence makes this a great educational chart for younger bands, but the chart is sophisticated enough for mature groups as well.

The first melody statement is at 13. Altos listen to Trumpets. No one needs to play too hard or loud here. Rhythm section should be tight on the stop time figures but not loud. Trombones and Tenors get the melody at 25. Be sure this melody has the same articulation as the melody at 13. Rhythm section here should be swingin'!

The solo section 37 starts with the band kicking off the beginning of each solo. Full and loud is the call here. Please note where some backgrounds are marked "Play 2nd x only" (like at 45) and some are marked "Play 1st x only" (like at 53). This provides for a different sound behind each soloist. Solos are available to many. The chart is written so that a soloist's background lines won't be missed while they solo.

At 61, volume should drop over the first 8 bars to signify the horns coming in soft at 69. Exaggerate the dynamics here, starting softer here will make the forte that much bigger at 81. Big full sounds with plenty of air are the call at 81. Be sure everyone balances to your lead Trumpet. Melody always rules!!

At 103, things come back down and build slowly with different lines entering at different times. Watch the volume here. The chart doesn't get loud again, just more people are playing at the same time as it builds to the last measure.

Mind Over Matters is a sophisticated sounding chart that is very accessible and fun for your audience to listen to. Suitable for any concert or festival, I hope you enjoy *Mind Over Matters*. If you have ANY questions, please feel free to contact me at krisbergjazz.com.
