



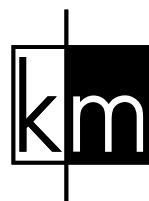

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Kris Berg

Kris Berg is an international best-selling composer and arranger. He has written charts for Kurt Elling, Sean Jones, Veronica Swift, Delfeayo Marsalis, Wayne Bergeron and Chris Vadala, for honors bands in Texas, Oklahoma, Arizona, South Carolina, Maine, Maryland and Missouri, and for professional, college and public school bands around the globe.

A recipient of 8 Global Music Awards, Mr. Berg has released two highly acclaimed CD's (MAMA Records) as leader of the Metroplexity Big Band. "Time Management" and "This Time/Last Year" feature his unique writing and arranging. "Perspectives", his new CD, was released in 2021. He has appeared or recorded with the likes of Wayne Bergeron, Phil Woods, Kurt Elling, Randy Brecker, Peter Erskine, Delfeayo Marsalis, and Bob Mintzer and has directed All-State Jazz Bands in Nebraska, Montana, Oklahoma, Maine, South Carolina,

Arkansas, South Dakota, Nevada, Kentucky, Ohio, Arizona, Texas and Wyoming.

Kris is currently the Jazz Program Director for the Greater Dallas Youth Orchestra program and Music Director at Willow Bend Church in Plano, Texas. He taught college for almost 30 years and is the founder of the award-winning Jazz Program at Collin College including the Collin Jazz Fest and the Texas All-Star Jazz Camp.

I Ain't Got Nobody

I Ain't Got Nobody is a popular 1915 standard by Spencer Williams. First recorded by Marion Harris, it has been recorded numerous times by artists from Louis Armstrong to Rosemary Clooney to Mos Def.

This should be a driving shuffle with a lot of fun thrown in! Drums can use a soft back beat for almost the entire tune to really bring that shuffle home. Bass should play right on top of the beat to keep the energy high.

After the loud intro, band grooves hard through the first parts of the tune. Listen and play together and in tune. At 33 the volume drops along with the stop time figures in the rhythm section, building to 41 and the Drum solo fill in 41 - 42.

At 50 the rhythm section goes into a jazz march. Bass and Piano should make a clear distinction between staccato and legato notes, exaggerating both. Horns should also exaggerate dynamics, especially starting as soft as possible at measure 52.

Solos are split up to feature 4 players, each with a half a chorus. Trombone and lead Alto first time through and then Tenor Sax and Trumpet the second time through. There is flexibility here. For example... 2 soloists that each play the entire way through or play 3 times through and have 6 soloists. Lots of possibilities.

Sections 88 and 92 are recaps of earlier sections and should be played as before. Measure 111 is new as we head to the ending. Really punch the last 3 bars, especially the Drums.

I Ain't Got Nobody should be high energy fun for both your performers and your audiences. I very much enjoyed shaping this very old standard into something fun to play. I hope you enjoy it.
