NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This arrangement is based on Rimsky-Korsakov's composition "Sheherazade-Symphonic Suite, Op. 35: III. The Young Prince and the Young Princess."

There are three different styles in this contemporary arrangement: The first is a loud unison rock feel in the introduction. If possible, try directing the band to play all the notes separated with what I call a "slice of silence" after each note to make the intro aggressive. Try rehearsing the melodic instruments together first and then adding the rhythm section after they've heard the "silence".

The Latin feel beginning in measure 11 should have a light two-feel so it feels like cut time. The wind instruments should be thinking in terms of eight bar phrases for breathing purposes. The melody beginning in measure 18 should have a smooth (soft tongue) legato feel even though there are short notes. The eighth notes in the melody line should be played in a slight swing style rather than strict even eighths. The rhythm section however should play a straight eighth note Latin feel behind the melody.

This is also true in measures 40–55. The melodic eighth notes should have a slight swing feel but the rhythm section plays strict even eighths.

The swing section in measures 57–80 is a full-out swing feel for everyone. Groupings of eighth notes should sound more like "doo-dle-doo-dle", rather than "tooh-tooh-tooh-tooh", or "tah-tah-tah". Measure 87 begins the "shout chorus" and should be the loudest, most exciting section of the piece. Drums and bass should need to be aware of the time and keep it moving so the tempo doesn't slow down in the swing section.

There is a transition in measures 101–105 back into the light Latin two-feel to finish out the arrangement.

Remind students that all the musical elements are especially important in a jazz band where each person is responsible for their own part. Dynamics, balance, blend, melody vs. backgrounds, bringing out the moving parts, and rhythmic precision and accuracy, are only the starting points for a worthy performance. A great performance is no accident! It happens when everyone is focused on the sound of the total ensemble and all aspects are carefully planned and worked out ahead of time. Above all, students should have fun performing and enjoy the music that they create.
