## Serenade from Swan Songs

Franz Schubert

Arranged by Elburz Sorkhabi

This *Serenade* was written by Franz Schubert and compiled into a collection called the *Schwanengesang* (*Swan Songs*). Unlike his other song cycles, this collection of pieces is inspired by and written using the poems of two poets, Ludwig Rellstab and Heinrich Heine. The *Serenade* belongs to a poem by the former which has been translated as:

My songs beckon softly  
through the night to you;  
below in the quiet grove,  
Come to me, beloved!

The rustle of slender leaf tips whispers  
in the moonlight;  
Do not fear the evil spying  
of the betrayer, my dear.

Do you hear the nightingales call?  
Ah, they beckon to you,  
With the sweet sound of their singing  
they beckon to you for me.

They understand the heart's longing,  
know the pain of love.  
They calm each lonely heart  
with their silver tones.

Let them also stir within your breast,  
beloved, hear me!  
Trembling I wait for you,  
Come, please me!

This piece, being a song, should be performed in a singing style. Emphasis should be placed on connecting phrase fragments to create a more complete melodic line. Although there are many different possible natural slurs that are possible in the piece, the performer should use a legato tonguing style for a more consistent and even sound throughout.
