NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Although his contribution to the Classical style of music is serious, Haydn was famous for including little tricks, jokes, or stories in his pieces. The second movement of this symphony is nicknamed "The Surprise Symphony." It begins simply and quietly, but just as the audience has had enough time to doze off, Haydn puts a loud chord in the music to wake them up! This movement became so famous that lyrics were added to it to create "Papa Haydn's" theme song.

This piece is in a theme-and-variation format. Each section adapts the original melody in a new way. The Coda begins like a rousing ending but tapers off enough for the concert goes to fall back to sleep, now that Haydn's piece on the program is finished!

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
