*)The short horizontal line_placed over a note signifies that it is to be sustained to its full duration; yet without being slurred on to the next note. The duration of a sound on the Piano depends less on the holding down of the finger after striking than on the mode of striking, or preparation therefor (the raising of the finger beforehand). A note marked with the horizontal line should, therefore, be played somewhat "marcato", not so much so, however as one marked >, or, still more emphatically, A.
