Giancarlo Castro est né en 1980 à Barquisimeto au Vénézuela dans une famille de musiciens. Il intègre "El Sistema*" à la trompette et ensuite en composition. Il a étudié au Conservatoire Vicente Emilio Sojo de Barquisimeto et à l'Institut d'Etudes Musicales de l'Université de Caracas.

Ses compositions vont de la musique académique à la musique latino. Certaines d'entre elles sont enregistrées chez EMI Classics et EuroArts.
